IMPORTANT - Parking Lot Information

HELP KEEP OUR SCHOOL SAFE

We have gotten very lax about following the rule of not leaving your vehicle in the Kiss and Go lane before and after school. If you plan to get out of your vehicle you must park in the parking lot or on the street. The reason you are asked to follow this rule is two-fold

1. It is the fire lane and if we ever needed to get a fire truck/rescue vehicle, we do not have time to track you down. If a law enforcement officer were on the property, you could actually be ticketed for this.
2. Equally as important, when we clog up the Kiss and Go lane, people are forced to try and navigate around you. This break in the flow puts pedestrians at a higher risk as drivers are not only looking for them, but trying to drive around cars whose doors may open up unexpectedly or who may decide to pull out from the curb.

Bottom line – **DO NOT LEAVE YOUR VEHICLE IN THE KISS AND GO LANE PLEASE.**
