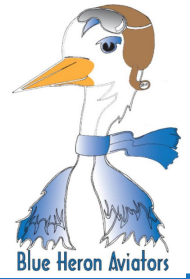

Choice Enrollment

Jeffco Public Schools has begun the "Choice Enrollment" process for the 2018-2019 school year. If you wish to attend Summit Ridge Middle School, and you do not live within our attendance boundary, you will need to complete a Choice Enrollment Application and bring it to Summit Ridge. Families that live within the attendance boundaries for Mt. Carbon Elementary, Westridge Elementary, Powderhorn Elementary, Colorow Elementary and Blue Heron Elementary are automatically within the attendance boundary for Summit Ridge. **If your family is outside these boundaries, you will need to complete an application.**

Parents, just a reminder, if you are choice enrolling at Summit Ridge and live in the Carmody articulation area, transportation will not be provided.

Attached to your Choice Enrollment Application, please attach a copy of your students Immunization Record and a copy of your Childs Birth Certificate.

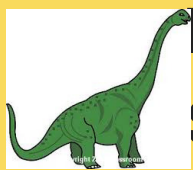
