EXECUTIVE SESSION: The Board of Education met in executive session to discuss property negotiations.

1. **PRELIMINARY**

- a. **CALL TO ORDER:** A regular meeting was called to order by Vince Chowdhury, First Vice President of the Board of Education, at 6:10 p.m. in the Board Room of the Education Services Center, 1829 Denver West Drive, Golden, Colorado, Thursday, January 25, 2007. No recess was held.
- b. **WELCOME TO THE AUDIENCE:** Mr. Chowdhury welcomed the audience.
- c. **PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:** At the invitation of Mr. Chowdhury, the assembly repeated the Pledge of Allegiance.
- d. **ROLL CALL:** Roll call indicated that a majority of the Board was present– Vince Chowdhury, First Vice President; Sue Marinelli, Second Vice President; Scott Benefield, Secretary; and Hereford Percy, Treasurer. Cynthia Stevenson, Superintendent, represented the administration.

Jane Barnes, President, was excused from the meeting.

e. **APPROVE AGENDA:**
